

Mobile Assessments Offline SCTT Completion

Councils who use the Aged Care Module have the option to purchase the Mobile Assessments, Offline SCTT Completion tool. Using Pocket PC Creations software, the SCTT Tool can be completed on a PDA (Personal Digital Assistant) and synchronised back to the Aged Care database.

Where City Manager Aged Care is used in the office to enter in the SCTT information, using a PDA (or laptop, if required) entry of SCTT forms can be done offsite, anywhere! In the clients home, their carers home, wherever the assessment/review is to occur. This will mean that paper based SCTT forms are not needed to be completed, and no double entry of the client information.



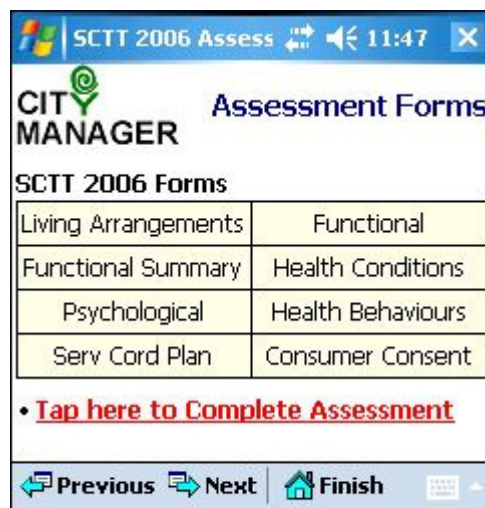
Select the required client from the Aged Care application to send to the PDA

Simply enter the info onto the PDA once and synchronise it back to Aged Care in a few simple steps upon returning to the office.

PDA's are extremely easy to use, light to carry and they can even have their own password to prevent unauthorised access to information.

Major features at a glance:

- Easy data entry of the SCTT information (point and click) with coloured screens and graphical images and on screen help text will assist with filling in the required fields.
- Use for Assessment and Reviews – wherever the SCTT is needed to be completed.
- PDA's are extremely easy to use.
- Potentially reduce OHS claims by not having to carry a heavy laptop around – average PDA's weigh around just 150 grams.
- Secure information – PDA's can be set with a password to prevent unauthorised access to client information.
- Send the file to the PDA in a few easy steps.
- No need for manual re -entry of data.
